
CEO's CORNER

This spring the State of NC awarded IT People a project to implement an anonymous safety tipping mobile app and pilot to 70 schools in 4 counties. The program will eventually be deployed to all 100 counties, 1500 middle and high schools throughout NC. The app will let students, parents and other individuals to anonymously report (Speak Up) bullying, drug abuse, alcohol abuse, fighting and other dangers in our schools. This is a complex project consisting of Android and Apple mobile applications, a management dashboard, learning management system, and single sign on integration with the State. We have made considerable progress to have the program ready for students in the Fall.


We have also noticed some interesting projects in the Big Data space. For example

Monsanto is using sensors at various spots in a crop growing area to measure terrain, sunshine, soil type, moisture, seed characteristics, growth etc.. This data is integrated with climate data from government satellites and weather stations, university research sensors, Monsanto's seed database and any other source they can find. It finally gets fed through a pipeline of data analysts and software engineers and emerges at the other end to support Precision agriculture. Monsanto believes that the key to solving global hunger lies in marrying agricultural practices with data science.
